


WHO WE ARE?:

- Multi-temperature warehousing services for frozen, chill, temperature controlled and dry goods
- Multi-custom regime services: duty paid, suspended duty, freeport, transhipment
- Value added services: sorting, labelling, tagging, packing, order preparation, distribution
- Continuous stock control: online and secured stock traceability, fully integrated information systems

MFD has developed the most efficient environment for logistics operations which comply with stringent security norms.

Our infrastructure

MFD has developed the largest and most comprehensive logistics platform in the Indian Ocean, offering wide range of warehousing solutions and equipment for handling.

56,000m² of Ambient Temperature Warehouses

Concrete built and fire resistant, MFD warehouses have been developed to the highest international standards, particularly in terms of engineering and firefighting equipment, security and hygiene.

The warehouses are equipped with a network of fire hose reels. The buildings have also been designed and built to withstand extreme cyclonic conditions.

19,000m² of Cold Rooms

MFD has the largest area of cold rooms in the Indian Ocean, offering 96,000m³ of storage. These are built to international standards (HACCP, ISO Etamp; EU) and are designed to store products at controlled temperatures ranging from -20°C to 8°C.

14,000m² of Industrial Zone

Individual industrial modules for value-added activities, as well as customised packaging for individual client needs, all in a highly secure environment.

6,000m² of Office Space

MFD has ready-to-use offices for lease, offering Business Centre facilities.

120 metres of quay

More than 10 metres deep, the fishing quay at the very centre of the commercial port is mainly used for unloading fish.









Container Park

MFD also manages a container park with a capacity of 7,000 TEUs, 120 reefer points for refrigerated containers and 5 reach stackers for handling full and empty containers.

Transport Fleet

To ensure a complete logistics offering, MFD uses a complete range of transport vehicles:

- side loaders trailers
 - flatbed trailers
 - lowbed trailers
 - dry goods delivery truck
 - temperature-controlled delivery truck
 - tipper trucks for offloading fish

Security

- 24-hour electronic surveillance equipped with infrared cameras and regularly
 patrolled by security guards
 - 24 hour-controlled access with rapid intervention
 - Inspection and control of merchandise entering and leaving MFD site.

Food and Distribution Retail Industry

Optimum service solutions being offered for the monthly preparation of 4,500 pallets representing 35,000 Mt of FMCG stock managed yearly.

Every month, our teams handle the equivalent of 4,500 pallets, in our cold and dry warehouses, which means that we handle and manage more than 35,000 MT of FMCG stock per year ».

Bulk Logistics

Wide range of logistics services coupled with modern facilities and expertise to assist the handling of wheat, bagged flour, maize or fish.

"With more than 80,000 m² of modern facilities, coupled with recognised expertise in handling bagged flour, maize, rice, fertilizers and fish, MFD is up to the challenge".

Textile

Cost-effective solutions to better accompany this industry in its export process.

"MFD aims to provide cost-effective solutions to what is considered a fixed cost generating process in the textile industry, that is, from end of the production lines to shipment, in other words the FOB part".

Seafood Hub

A customized supply chain solution with specific equipment where more than 85,000 Mt of fish are handled every day. MFD has developed and built dedicated infrastructure along with specialised services which meet the demands of the fishing industry. "Designed to European (EU) standards our infrastructure enables us to handle more than 85,000 Mt of seafood per year – unloading, sorting, stocking at -20 °C or -40 °C, and forwarding to local factories or international distribution networks."

Container Park services

Vast experience in the handling and stock management of containers, with more than 40,000 containers being moved a year.

« Equipped with best -in -class infrastructure and IT systems, we handle over 40,000 containers per year. Our teams carry out daily operations such as washing, repairs, paper lining, upgrading, general maintenance and pre-trip inspection. We are able to evacuate more than 500 containers a day. »

The Freeport legislation provides for a comprehensive package of liberal incentives for companies looking for a cost-effective storage, assembly and redistribution platform.

Freeport companies in Mauritius benefit from many advantages:

- Efficient customs clearing process
- 3% Preferential Corporate Taxation
- Duty free and VAT Free goods and equipment
- Exemption on CSR (Corporate Social Responsibility) contribution
- 100% foreign ownership is possible
- Free repatriation of profits
- No foreign exchange control
- 50% of reduction on port handling charges
- Local market sales
- Access to Offshore Banking facilities
